



Put Yourself in Our Boots

Think your workplace is safe? Put yourself in the boots of emergency responders – police, firefighters and paramedics – who may have to attend your unfamiliar premise during an emergency. Your workplace is their workplace . . . *is it safe?*

We all have a responsibility to ensure the safety and health of people in our work areas, whether they are our friends, coworkers, or emergency responders.

This John Petropoulos Memorial Fund project includes the production of a short safety video and three 30-second PSAs intended for television and online broadcast. The PSAs reflect the different perspectives of police, fire and EMS personnel and they put the viewer in the boots of emergency responders. The safety video provides solutions to ensure a workplace is safe for *everyone*.

This video is a must-have for building and safety inspectors, construction site superintendents, facility managers, building owners and those involved in workplace health and safety. It is an excellent resource for safety meetings, public presentations, community events, and relevant high school and post-secondary classes. Safety training and recruit classes for emergency responders will also want to use the video to inform police, firefighters and paramedics about hazards they may encounter on calls at workplaces.
