After he touches down, skydiver Darren Strocher will discuss the importance of workplace safety in his life. Strocher will also be joined by other speakers, who will discuss occupational safety and health.



NAOSH Week 2010 takes place from May 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> and this year's theme is: *Safety & Health: A Commitment for Life. How safe are you?*
